



What happens next?

✓ ~~If all your documents are in, the file will leave here soon.~~

✓ ~~meeting. Can~~ take a few months. You do not have to come back here for the meeting. Will be on computer. (3/24)

✓ ~~At that meeting our reports will be reviewed and the determination will be made whether your child needs special education services.~~

4 Options:

- ~~1. Child does not need services.~~
- ~~2. Child needs speech/language therapy. You bring child to the school for therapy, wait for them, and then bring them back home or to daycare.~~
- ~~3. Child needs an all day, M-F program.~~
- ~~4. Child needs an all day, M-F program AND speech/language therapy.~~

✓ If your child needs services an Individual Education Plan (IEP) will be developed. *Needs all day + speech.*

Frequently asked questions

✓ ~~Is there a bus? If your child is eligible for the full day program-Yes. If your child qualifies for speech/language only then transportation is not provided. The bus has a driver and an attendant.~~

✓ ~~What are school hours? If your child qualifies for a full day program hours are the same as the school schedule for that school (usually 8:20-3:20 but a few schools are different). If your child qualifies for speech/language only, the therapist will schedule a therapy time with you.~~

✓ ~~Does child need to be toilet trained? No. They will work on that if they feel child is ready.~~

✓ ~~How many kids in class? Varies but somewhere around 12-15 kids with two adults.~~

* ~~Is it a problem if child misses due to therapy or Dr. appts? No. Attendance is not mandatory. However, it is beneficial for your child to have a consistent schedule.~~

✓ ~~What supplies will my child need? You will get that information at your meeting at the school.~~
